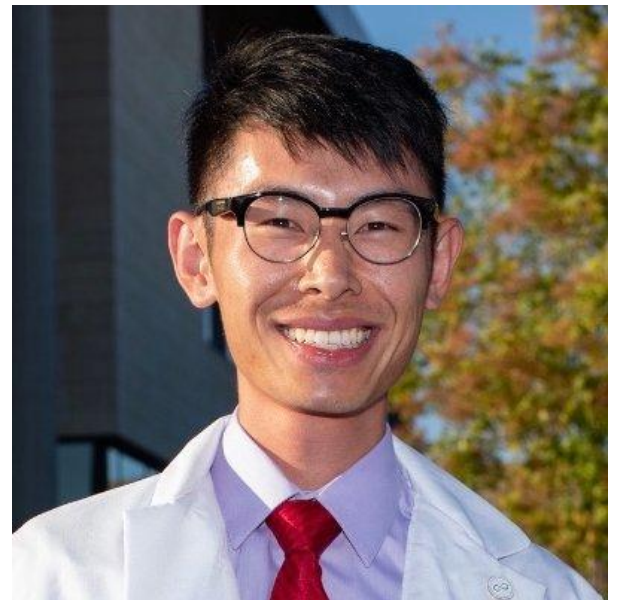
Mr. Qian is also a board member at ASDRP, where he provides key perspectives in strategy for bringing student research to the next level.
