

## Senior Scholar-Scientist Achievement Award!

# **Due December 20th at 11:59 PM PST**

This award is the highest level of distinction for a senior research student at ASDRP who we believe exemplifies the spirit of the institution.

Every year, ASDRP produces some of the best high school researchers in the country, who go on to do fantastic things in college and beyond. The Graduating Senior Scholar-Scientist Award is designed to recognize outstanding seniors for a track record of excellence in research at ASDRP.

#### What is the award?

- Dues waived for the second semester of the recipient's senior year
- 2. Formal award given at Spring 2023 Symposium
- 3. Recieve a \$150 gift certificate to Amazon.com or another vendor of their choice

### Who is eligible?

- 1. Be entering their final semester of high school in the Winter/Spring of 2023 and enrolled full time in school
- 2. Have a standing (unweighted) GPA above 3.75 and must upload an official or unofficial transcript
- 3. Have been at ASDRP for five continuous semesters prior to the awarding semester (must have started no later than the summer after sophomore year)
- Be endorsed by their research advisor with a letter of endorsement submitted to <u>asdrp.admin@asdrp.org</u> no later than 11:59 pm PST on December 20, 2022
- 5. Complete the online application due December 20th at 11:59 pm PST

Applicants will be evaluated on Innovation, Scientific Pedigree, and Service. Please see the application at the link in the student portal!

Awardee will be notified on December 27, 2022 via email and will be publicly recognized at the Spring Symposium in June
